**Charging and Remissions for 2023-24**

**Charging and Remission for Instrumental Music Tuition**

1. The governors seek, by charging fees to those with parental responsibility, to recoup a small proportion of the charge upon the school budget for instrumental tuition.
2. Payment is due termly in advance or in one instalment via Parent Pay. See below:

**Autumn Term: Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023**

**Spring Term: Friday 24<sup>th</sup> November 2023**

**Summer Term: Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2024**

In groups (up to 3 students – suitable for beginners to Grade 3:

- £102.00 per term (£306.00 per year) 30-minute lesson (2023/24 prices)

One to One lessons (Recommended for students from Grade 3 upwards):

- £138.00 per term (£414.00 per year) 30-minute lesson (2023/24 prices)

No refunds given if the student gives up or school withdraws tuition due to poor attendance.

3. We are no longer using any Entrust music services (other than those provided by Entrust's AYM Scheme which is funded through themselves not via the school or student)
4. Where a student is eligible for Pupil Premium full remission of charges for tuition, exam fees and accompaniment will apply.
5. All other students taking ABRSM exams and needing accompaniment a fee will apply for both the exam and the accompanist.
6. All questions of remission will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.
7. There is a maximum of three students in any group where students receive instrumental tuition.
8. Where, in a particularly short term, it is not possible to offer twelve lessons, the balance could be provided in the longer, subsequent term, but within the same school year. Where a student misses lessons for reasons over which the school has no control (e.g. owing to illness or holidays) there is no reimbursement or carry over of fees.

## Charging and Remission for Trips/Visits:

1. Where a student is eligible for Pupil Premium the contribution will be decided by either the Head of School or the Senior Leader responsible for Pupil Premium progress
2. All questions of remission will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.
