

## **"Polite Reminder to Parents/Carers from the School Age Immunisation Service"**

We will be visiting school on **Thursday, 14<sup>th</sup> December 2023** to deliver the Nasal Flu spray programme to those pupils in **Year 7 – Year 11**. Unfortunately, if a consent is received outside of this age range, then your child will not be vaccinated in line with national guidance. Thank you to those who have completed the on-line consent form already. If you have not done so and would like your child protected against Flu please complete the consent form by **10am on Thursday, 7<sup>th</sup> December 2023** using the following link: <https://forms.mpft.nhs.uk/>

If there have been any changes to your child's health 14 days before to the vaccination date **YOU MUST** contact the immunisation team on 0300 124 0366, as your child may not be well enough to receive the vaccination:

- Your child is asthmatic and becomes wheezy
- Has required oral steroids
- Has increased their asthma medication

If you have any concerns regarding the vaccination, have taken your child to the GP for their vaccination, or require support completing the consent form, please do not hesitate to contact a member of the Immunisation Service to discuss on 0300 124 0366.

*It is important that parents are made aware of the session date so that they can notify our team if there are any changes in their child's health conditions particularly asthma or if their child has received the vaccination via their GP practice, since completing the consent form.*
