## **School Funding Crisis**

School funding and falling budgets are hot topics at the moment and you may be wondering how you can help your school.

## **Meeting Challenges Together**

While the Government is being confronted to address the funding challenges, parents are not powerless to assist their school. We strongly believe that school and parents working in partnership is the most positive way to raise money and secure the best educational experiences for our children. Did you know that last year, your PTFA raised £8,387 through fundraising, which paid for Easter eggs for whole school Easter Egg Hunt, membership and training for Girls on Board (empowering girls to find their own solutions), part funded activities week for students and donated to local charity Chase Lighthouse?

The good news is, everything your PTFA raises goes directly to providing for the school, and, in consultation with staff, parents have a say on where and how the money is spent.

This year we are looking to raise money to support the following:

- 1. Part-funding Activities Week building memories for children who do not have the opportunities to do so during the summer holidays and allowing all children to be rewarded for their hard work
- 2. A third table tennis table for children to use at lunch we have raised money for 2 already and they promise to be popular
- 3. Replacing the school curtains and lighting in the hall to support school productions
- 4. Robotics equipment for the new Computer Science GCSE and virtual headsets for Geography to provide exciting opportunities that go beyond the normal curriculum
- 5. Resources and opportunities to enhance the enrichment curriculum, allowing us to offer opportunities that really make a difference to our children
- 6. Fund summer games and activities for children to use at lunch time including skipping ropes, footballs and garden games.
