Dear Parents / Carers,

As we enter the last week of the spring term I wanted to write and celebrate the way that students have returned to their studies after the third lockdown. As parents you should feel very proud of their kindness towards staff and other students as well as the effort that they have put into their studies.

## Safe Easter Holiday

To ensure that all families have a safe and restful Easter we are asking students to slightly change their pattern of testing next week. This is to reduce the possibility of school staff from having to identify close contacts over the Easter weekend and ask families to isolate. We are asking students to test on the following days before coming into school.

Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March <u>and</u> Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April. If they test positive, they should book a PCR test, notify school and start to isolate. School will identify close contacts in the previous 48 hours and contact them to isolate. The next test should be Monday 5<sup>th</sup> April. After this test they should inform track and trace and not school for close contacts in the previous 48 hours to be identified.

Testing should then continue with a gap of three/four days. As the holiday ends we would like all staff and students to test the day before we return to school on –

## Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> April

This pattern of testing will help us to reduce the number of A symptomatic students and staff who are in contact before Easter resulting in families needing to isolate during this family holiday.
