Dear Parents and Carers,

As a part of your child's education at Kingsmead, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal Development programme that includes Relationships, Sexual Health and Health Education (RSHE). Personal Development is the curriculum subject that gives young people the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

As part of this curriculum, our young people are taught about topics such as grooming, sexual exploitation and domestic abuse, including coercive and controlling behaviour. This is taught in an age-appropriate, sensitive, and clear way so that our students can understand the effects in current/future relationships, whilst also explaining the legal position on sexual exploitation, gangs and criminal exploitation. including 'county lines'.

I am writing to let you know that on Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> January 2024 your child will be taking part in a specially designed session on grooming and Child Sexual Exploitation (CSE) run by LOUDMOUTH who create powerful lessons through theatre and workshops. Your child will be taking part in a 1-hour drama production before a one 20-30minute workshop with LOUDMOUTH educators.
