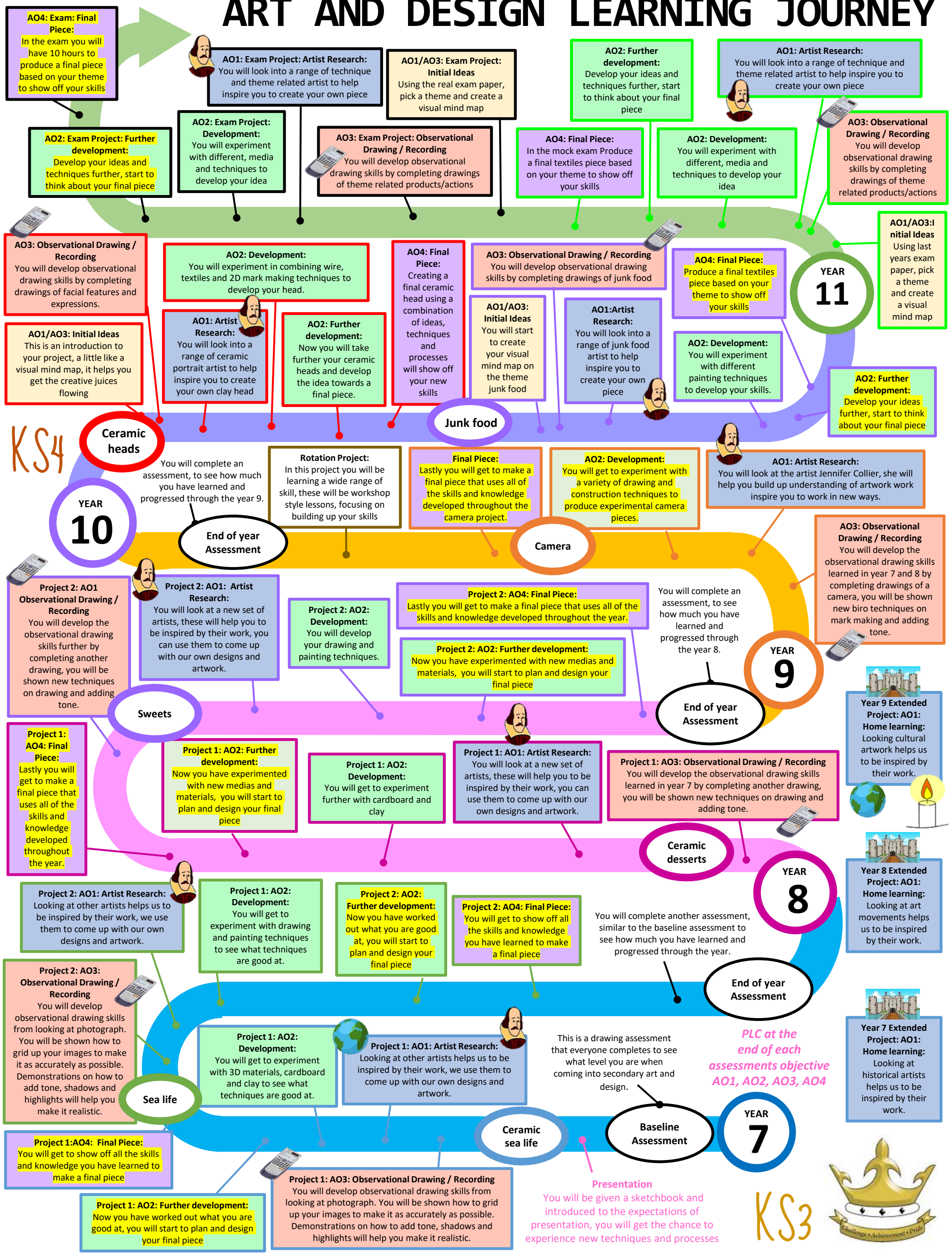


# ART AND DESIGN LEARNING JOURNEY

You will look into a range of ceramic portrait artist to help inspire you to create your own clay head

**AO2: Development:**  
You will experiment in combining wire, textiles and 2D mark making techniques to develop your head.

**AO3: Observational Drawing / Recording**  
You will develop observational drawing skills by completing drawings of facial features and expressions.

This is an introduction to your project, a little like a visual mind map, it helps you get the creative juices flowing

**AO1: Artist Research:**  
You will look at the artist Jennifer Collier, she will help you build up understanding of artwork work inspire you to work in new ways.

You will get to experiment with a variety of drawing and construction techniques to produce experimental camera pieces.

**Baseline Assessment**

This is a drawing assessment that everyone completes to see what level you are when coming into secondary art and design.
