

Class Expectations at Kingsmead

EXPECTATIONS NOT MET BY PUPIL

This could be for incomplete work, lack of effort in lessons, lack of effort in homework, distraction of others

A discussion is had with the pupil regarding their behaviour and what they will need to do to correct it

Staff are responsible for the learning behaviour in their classrooms. Therefore, the systems are not to be used as an exit strategy but a change in pupil behaviour to de-escalate situation with conversation and refocussing strategies

EXPECTATIONS NOT MET BY PUPIL

The pupil is reminded of what expectations are and is moved to correct their behaviour if possible

It is essential at this point that pupils are reminded of our expectations and that should they not be met then escalation to PREP may occur

EXPECTATIONS NOT MET BY PUPIL

The pupil is sent to sector call out.
When they return they will be issued a sanction on G4S and the reason explained again

- *Pupil is sent to sector call out with work to complete*
- *Staff record sanction on G4S and allocate detention*
- *When pupil returns sanction date is given to pupil and reason for explained again*
 - *Pupil collects equipment and leaves*

PUPIL ATTENDS SANCTION

Staff give pupils the work to be completed and explain how this is the opportunity to correct their behaviour

- *Staff arrive and set work for pupil to complete and reiterate expectations and reason why in PREP*
- *Register is taken by staff running the session and attendance by pupil and work completed recorded*

PUPIL FAILS TO ATTEND SANCTION

Staff running the prep session record the absence and behaviour team reset the sanction which is then attended the next evening

PUPIL FAILS TO ATTEND SANCTION

Behaviour team set the pupil a week PREP session to re-address behaviour concerns
